Must read

Before using your edco wheels read these instructions carefully. We also recommend looking at our user guides at www.edco.ch for tire installation, tubeless ready and brake pad adjustments. It is also good to understand the do's & don'ts for the edco wheels.

Where to use edco wheels

- edco wheels are made for road cycling
- they are designed for road/endurance or gravel bikes
 - not for tandems and trikes
 - not for MTB and off-road use
- the total system weight is limited to 120 kg
- if wheels are made for rim brake – use them with rim brakes and the edco brake pads only
- if wheels are made for disc brake – don't use them with rim brakes
- we recommend tire widths of 23, 25 and 28 mm

Quick Release & Through-axles

Only use the edco wheels with the edco Quick release or the Quick release and Through-axles provided with your bike or the fork manufacturer.

- Before every ride ensure that the QR is closed tightly
- With TA check the instructions from your bike, frame or fork manufacturer
- Make sure that your frame and fork are compatible with the parts before using

Before & after riding

Check your bike, the wheel set and all of your components before and after riding carefully. If you recognize any issue don't ride, make sure everything is repaired and serviced.

Wear and tear is a result of normal use. You should check the following:

- Roundness and flatness of your wheels
- Brake performance
- Tire correctness and air pressure
- Optical damages

We recommend cleaning the wheels and the bike on a regular basis and if you ride in dusty or on roads with salt clean it offing as soon as possible.

While the materials and craftsmanship of edco wheels maybe covered by a warranty or a crash replacement program for a defined period, this is not a guarantee that the product will last the term of warranty without failure. The warranty is not meant to suggest that the wheel or its component cannot be broken or will last forever. It means that the wheel set is covered subject to the terms of warranty (more information to be found at www.edco.ch).

Good to know

- Clean your wheels with water and liquid soap or a specific bike cleaner (we recommend tunap products); do not use a pressure washer as this will damage bearings and reduce the life time of your wheels significantly
- Do not use solvents, detergents, paints or any abrasives. This may damage your wheels and parts.
- Avoid to leave your wheels exposed to very high or cold temperatures
- Make sure that your ILT (integrated low temperature) brake surface is always clean. Do not apply any lubricant, grease or oil to the brake pads neither the braking surface at any time.
- Some braking noise may occur with new edco wheels and a red mark might be visible around the braking surface. This will stop when the wheels and brake pads have been used for some kilometres (e.g. > 300 km)
